Wis. Stat. §§ 181.1100 through 181.1161: Merger; Conversion—Nonstock Corporations

Provisions govern mergers and conversions of nonstock corporations.

Wis. Stat. §§ 183.1200 through 183.1207: Merger; Conversion—Limited Liability Companies

Provisions govern mergers and conversions of limited liability companies.

Wis. Stat. §§ 601.80 through 601.85: Healthcare Stability Plan

Defines phrases such as "healthcare stability plan" and "coinsurance rate" which means the rate set under another section of this staute for the healthcare stability plan that is the rate at which the commissioner will reimburse an eligible health carrier for claims incurred for an enrolled individual's covered benefits in a benefit year above the attachment point and below the reinsurance cap.

Wis. Stat. §§ 611.71 through 611.79: Corporate Reorganization—Domestic Stock

and Mutual Insurance Corporations

Provisions govern mergers, acquisitions, and conversions involving insurance corporations.

Wis. Stat. §§ 625.01 through 625.34: Insurance-Rate Regulation

The purposes of this chaptr are: to protect policyholders and the public against the adverse effects of excessive, inadequate or unfairly discriminatory rates; to encourage reasonable price competition among insurers; to provide formal regulatory controls if independent action and price competition fair; to authorize cooperative action among insurers in the rate-making process, and to regulate such cooperation in order to prevent practices that tend to bring about monopoly; etc.

Wis. Stat. §§ 635.01 through 635.19: Small Employer Health Insurance

Provides rate regulation for small employer health insurance. Lists what a small employer insurer shall disclose to a small employer before the sale of a plan or policy subject to the this chapter (Small Employer Health Insurance).

Wis. Stat. § 134.90. Uniform trade secrets act: Miscellaneous Trade Regulations

Governs misappropriation of trade secrets, injunctive relief, damages, preservation of secrecy, effect of provision on other laws, and uniformity of application and construction.

Wis. Stat. § 146.903. Disclosures required of health care providers and hospitals: Miscellaneous Health Provisions

Except as provided in par. (g), a health care provider or the health care provider's designee shall, upon request by and at no cost to a health care consumer, disclose to the consumer within a reasonable period of time after the request, the median billed charge, assuming no medical complications, for a health care service, diagnostic test, or procedure that is specified by the consumer and that is provided by the health care provider.

Wis. Stat. § 448.21. Physician assistants: Medical Practices

Provisions govern activities of physician assistants.

State Telehealth Laws and Reimbursement Policies
