[Article Highlight] Why the Biden Administration Should Help States Develop Capitated Public Options

A new article published in the <u>Milbank Quarterly Opinion</u> proposes the new Biden administration should help states develop capitated public options as part of its health policy agenda, which could lay the groundwork for a federal public option. Authored by Source Advisory Board Member <u>Richard Scheffler</u> and Thomas Rice, the article examines the recent efforts of Washington and Colorado in developing quasipublic options in their states. The authors identify specific states, including California, Massachusetts, and Rhode Island, as being most ready for such a risk-based capitation program. Finally, they call for federal support from the new administration through Section 1332 waivers for these state programs.
